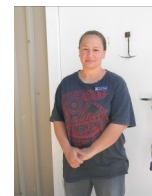

The school is collecting cards for the Woolworths Ancient Animals book, If you have any doubles that you don't want, please drop them into the school.



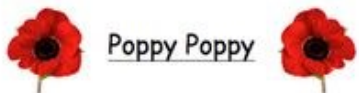
