Secretary: Jenny Hayes

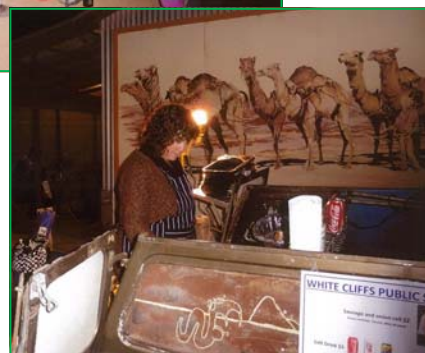
