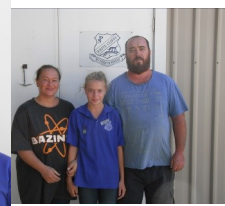
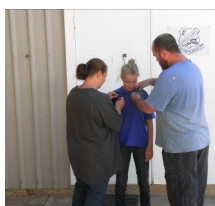
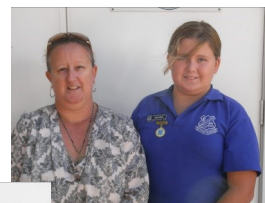
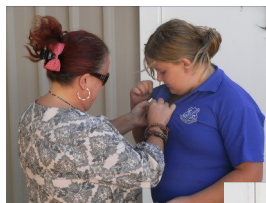
### STEWART HOUSE AWARD
